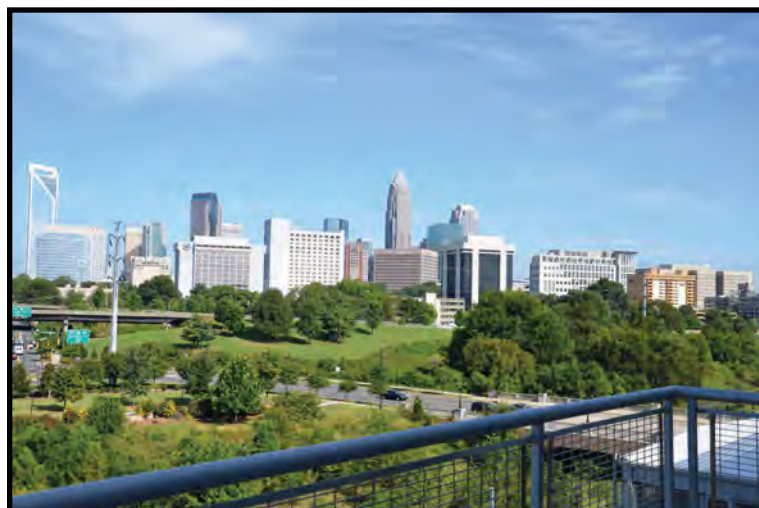


# RACIAL GAP IN NONPROFIT LEADERSHIP
